

Multi-Print function tops list of new features

The new Multi-Print print function allows you to combine up to twenty saved searches into one print request. This new feature was first suggested to us by Chas of Whidbey Island. Thanks Chas and everyone else who gave us great upgrade ideas; we have many upgrades now in development based on your input!

The new print feature saves you time when you print your reports. Simply click on the check boxes adjacent to the Saved Search reports that you want to print, then click on the Printer Icon at the bottom of the Saved Search list. This will individually print all of your selected reports with one print request.

Multi-print can be used anytime. The reports actually print individually, in the same order as displayed in the Saved Search list. For more information, logon on to CourtTrax, click on Help, then click the link titled Multi-Print Printing Function.



Clues: Case Types for District and Municipal Non-Civil cases

Case type titles used by the District or Municipal courts for non-civil cases are often not very helpful.

Criminal Non-Traffic, Criminal Traffic, Infraction Non Traffic, Infraction Traffic, Criminal Felony and Probable Cause- what do these mean?

The detailed court record for each case provides a specific case type, but this information is only available if you retrieve the detailed record. CourtTrax has compiled examples of specific charges associated with each of these case types, from actual case data. For example, a Criminal Traffic case type can be a

charge of Reckless Driving or Driving Under the Influence (DUI). For more information, logon on to CourtTrax, click on Help, then click the link titled District & Municipal Non-Civil Case Types.

Reviews: Retrieving multiple cases in one search

CourtTrax Multi-trieve allows users to simultaneously search for up to five distinct case numbers in the same court and county in combination with Dispatch and Resume. With Multi-trieve you can get up to 5 times the throughput of sequential searches. The CourtTrax court search servers will concurrently process your individual search requests saving you valuable time.

Case numbers are entered, separated by commas in the case number field. Click Submit to launch a Multi-trieve Dispatch and Resume Search. Each case number is returned as a separate report in the Saved Search Reports list. For more information, logon on to CourtTrax, click on Help, then click the link titled Multi-trieve for Case Number Searches.
